YEAR 5 – OSBOURNE HOUSE TRIP - Thursday 10 October 2019

To support and enrich their study of the Victorians, we have arranged an educational visit to Osbourne House, Isle of Wight for the children in Year 5. The children will find out more about life during Queen Victoria's reign, and how she ruled a country and raised a family at Osbourne House away from court life.

In order to make the most of our day, children must be dropped off <u>at the Foot Passenger Entrance</u> <u>of Red Funnel Ferry Terminal, Southampton, between 8:15am – 8:30am on Thursday 10 October.</u> Please do not drop your child off any earlier, as no one from school will be there to supervise. Unfortunately any child <u>arriving after this time will be unable to get on the Ferry, and should return</u> <u>to school.</u> We will be arriving back to Southampton at 4:30pm, therefore please collect your child from the Foot Passenger Entrance of Red Funnel Ferry Terminal, Southampton between 4:30 – 4:40pm prompt!

A packed lunch will be required on the day. If your child is entitled to a free school dinner please complete the slip below so that we can inform the school cook in good time. Please also make sure your child brings a water bottle in addition to their drink for lunch, and also a small snack, as it will be a very long day for them.

All children will need to wear their school jumper and polo-shirt, however they may wear black leggings / black joggers. They can also wear trainers / comfortable walking boots as they will be doing lots of walking.

There is an ice-cream shop at Osbourne House, and as a year group we thought it would be nice to share an ice-cream together. If you would like your child to have an ice-cream, please also indicate on the attached form and enclose an extra £2. However this is completely voluntary.

The cost of the visit it **£7.60 + £2 (for an ice-cream) per child**. If you would like to contribute more, naturally we would be grateful. Anyone who has difficulty with paying this amount, we would be grateful for any amount you can give, so that no child misses out on this great opportunity to enrich their education by experiencing this period of history first hand. **Please ensure that contributions are sent into school Monday 30th September 2019**.
