



PUPIL PREMIUM GRANT

The Pupil Premium Grant is government funding given to schools to support children in their learning.

The amount of funding we receive through the Pupil Premium Grant (PPG) is calculated on the number of children registered for Pupil Premium within the school.

Schools will only receive the PPG funding if families sign up for this entitlement. Our school will receive £1320 a year per child, if you are eligible.

The funding will be used for:

- Extra support and 1:1 tuition
- Challenge and support interventions
- Reduced rates for music lessons, clubs and visits
- Financial support with uniform costs

You qualify for PPG if you are in receipt of one of the following:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseekers Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- the guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- Child tax credit with an annual gross income into the household that is no more than £16,190, provided you are not entitled to working tax credit. If you are entitled to any part of working tax credit there is no eligibility with the exception of working tax run-on as shown below
- Working Tax Credit run-on - paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit
